### Activities

To create impact, Koe Koe Tech strives to:

- Provide trainings
- Generate savings/cost savings
- Provide goods and services
- Ensure women are part of the impact goal

Koe Koe Tech provides training (i.e. Financial literacy training, Training to access new markets and Life skills training). It has conducted 50 training sessions in the last 12 months, equipping 500 people with new skills and knowledge. Each training session is 16 hours on average. Beneficiaries are not required to practice their learnings after receiving training.

### Outcomes

As a result of its intentions and activities, Koe Koe Tech has achieved the following outcomes:

- Increased skills and knowledge/ education
- Women's empowerment
- Improved health

### Recommendations
